Workshop Title	Date/Time	Trainer	Class Description
Special Care Increment (SCI) Training (Formerly known as D and F-Rate training)	August 2, 3, 4 2022, 5pm-9pm **YOU MUST ATTEND ALL THREE SESSIONS**	Sandra Smith	The Special Care Increment (SCI) Training is the 12 hours foundational training for resource parents who are caring for children, adolescents and non-minor dependents who require specialized care resulting in resource parents going above and beyond the basic level of care (LOC) to meet a child's health, physical, emotional, behavioral, educational, permanency and family service needs. This training covers an overview and explanation of LOC & SCI, substance use, medication and behavior management, the impact of trauma on development, navigating the educational system, birth parent engagement, self-care and resources for successful SCI placement.
Documentation & Record Keeping (renewal for RFA, W, SCI-Specialized)	August 9, 2022, 5:00pm-9:00pm	Denetra Norwood & Sandra Smith	This workshop covers the importance of documentation and record keeping. As well, it shows the proper way of documenting events and keeping records effectively. At the end of the workshop we expect caregivers to make documentation a part of their everyday routine, as well as making them aware of the importance of documentation and how it can protect them as well as the child's well being
Understanding Grief and Loss (renewal for RFA, W, SCI-Specialized)	August 11, 2022, 5:30pm-8:30pm	Denetra Norwood	This class will help caregivers understand the grief and loss process. How children may act when confronted by stages of grief. To explore how grief and loss affect our own lives and how we can help our children to process their losses. This workshop will particular focus on what happens when a child goes through multiple placements, and the impact this has on the child; as every move is a trauma for them.
Transitioning to Adulthood (renewal for RFA, W, SCI-Specialized)	August 15, 2022, 5:30pm-8:30pm	Rob Hanna	Participants will examine the many facets of the adolescent transition period between childhood and adulthood [physical, psychosocial, mental]. Resource parents will learn to recognize some of the normal tensions that might occur at home and how to manage these issues.
How to Keep Our Teens Out of the System (renewal for RFA, W)	August 18, 2022, 5:00pm-8:00pm	Rob Hanna	Sometimes our youth will be involved with the Juvenile Court System. How can we support them and help them stay out of trouble?
Dealing with Aggressive Youth (renewal for RFA, W, SCI-Specialized)	August 22, 2022, 5:30pm-8:30pm	Rob Hanna	Anger is a way to communicate how we feel inside. Many youth that have experienced trauma and abuse behave in an aggressive way. Class will discuss how to deal with aggressive youth, and strategies on how to help them regulate these behaviors.
When Should You Talk About Sex Education? (renewal for RFA, W, SCI-Specialized)	August 24, 2022, 5:00pm-8:00pm	Sandra Smith	This workshop will focus on how as caregivers we are the best person to educate are children about sexuality. When talking with children about sexual matters, caregivers should be receptive to the child's language but supply proper terms? "Never avoid a teachable moment". This should be seen as the most meaningful and private communication.
Domestic Violence and Childhood Trauma (renewal for RFA, W, SCI-Specialized)	August 31, 2022, 5:00pm-8:00pm	Sandra Smith	Defining domestic violence and the various types of domestic violence will be discussed. Learn how domestic violence can affect the child. Techniques to help and heal the traumatized child will also be a part of this class.
