Medical Coding & Billing Series

According to the US Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), the projection of growth and demand for medical coders and billers is growing rapidly. With the skill set you will obtain in this series, you will be prepared to sit for the license exam for a national certification with AAPC or AHIMA.

So if you're interested in working with a doctor's office, clinic or healthcare facility, dental office, insurance company, or independent billing company, LACC Extension's Medical Insurance Series is a great place to start your career or expand on your skills!

Part 1: Medical Terminology

To work in healthcare, knowing medical terminology and having the ability to communicate with physicians, dentists, and other medical professionals is a must. Learning medical terminology will open the door to many job opportunities in the healthcare field. Students in this course will receive thorough instruction in developing fluency with medical terms covering the different body systems, body orientation, diseases, and medical treatments. By the end of this course, you will be familiar with word components for quick mastery of countless medical terms and be able to communicate effectively with peers in the field.

Part 2: Medical Insurance Coding

In physician practice it is common for the Medical Biller to also be the Medical Coder because physicians depend on the Biller/Coder to determine the diagnostic codes for procedures. In this class, you will learn how to find the proper procedure (CPT-4) and diagnostic codes (ICD-10), how to do proper code sequencing, and when to use these codes.

Prerequisite: Medical Terminology or experience in the medical field.

Required Books: *ICD-10-CM for Physicians* (Professional or Expert). Any preferred publisher. *CPT Professional Edition* (CPT/Current Procedural Terminology). Published by American Medical Association. For both books, old editions are permitted up to 2018 if only to be used for practice (2021, 2020, 2019, 2018). Current edition if to be used for current year's license exam.

Drone Pilot Program

There is a large demand for drone pilots right now, and the drone industry is expected to grow by over 50% over the next five years. Whether it be in real estate, agriculture, transportation, telecommunications, energy, or filmmaking, being a drone pilot is a viable career path.

If making a living flying drones, or even just flying for recreation, sounds great, then this program is for you. LACC Extension's Drone Pilot Program is designed to prep students to pass the FAA exam to become a certified commercial drone pilot and to give students the foundational drone skills needed to fly drones professionally. Taught by Skip Fredricks, one of the top drone pilots and instructors, this program consists of two parts:

- 1) 16 hours of live, online FAA exam prep to certify you as a commercial drone pilot
- 2) 24 hours of hands-on, in-person drone flight training

For the FAA prep portion of the program, students will need to purchase the Remote Pilot Test Prep app at www.sportys.com, which costs \$19.99. For the flight training portion of the program, students will need to bring a safety helmet and safety vest. No more than 12 students will be able to register for the flight training portion of the program. **No class Apr 9.**

Become a Notary Public or Renew Your Commission

All prospective notaries must complete a course approved by the California Secretary of State. Our approved course will give you the most updated notary information and the knowledge you need to pass the state exam and perform your duties correctly. Becoming a notary and notary loan signing agent can be a great way to earn extra money, start your own business, or enhance your current career.



Class fee includes a valuable 70-page manual, the ability to take the State Exam after the class (in-person classes only) notary public handbook, certificate of completion, notary public application and sample forms notaries use every day.

State examination is conducted on the same day immediately after class starting at 4:30PM.
