LOS ANGELES CITY COLLEGE HOSTS DATATHON COMPETITION

Event offers students experience in coding and datasets

(November 20, 2024) — Los Angeles City College (LACC) hosted their first Datathon competition on November 2, 2024. The event brought together 80 participants including LACC alumni, guests and speakers for a day of problem-solving, creativity and learning. Students received hands-on experience in data science, helping them build skills in coding, data visualization and the ability to analyze problems using real-world datasets. The students were also introduced to RStudio, an integrated development environment utilizing a programming language for statistical computing and visualization.

The students worked in teams to analyze datasets and present findings. “The event provided a fun and challenging environment and an opportunity for students to network and build connections within community colleges and 4-year institutions,” said LACC Mathematics Department Chair Professor Kee Lam.

Students and faculty from Cal Poly Pomona, CSU Channel Islands, UC Santa Barbara, and Long Beach City College participated as well as faculty and students from the LACC Math Department and CSISA Department.
