The LACCD associate-level general education plan is appropriate for students planning to earn an associate degree who do not plan to transfer to a baccalaureate granting institution. Although courses may be listed in multiple general education areas (A-E), a course can be given credit in only one GE subject area. This advisement sheet can be modified or updated from time to time. Consult with a counselor regarding which catalog year and GE pattern may be more beneficial and appropriate to graduate. Per Administrative Procedure 4100:

- **Unit Requirement:** Minimum 60 units of course credit in a selected curriculum (i.e., major, GE, competency requirements).
- **Scholarship Requirement:** A "C" (2.0) grade average or higher in all work attempted in the curriculum upon which the degree is based. A "C" is defined as a minimum 2.0 grade points on a 4.0 scale.
- **Residence Requirement:** Completion of at least 12 units of work in residence and attendance at a LACCD college. Exceptions may be made due to injustice or undue hardship.
- **Major Requirements:** A minimum of 18 units in a single or related field must be completed to graduate. For students entering fall 2009 or after, each course counted towards the major or area of emphasis requirement must be completed with a C grade or better.
- **Competency Requirements:** Reading and Written Expression, Mathematics, and Ethnic Studies.
- **General Education Requirements:** Students may satisfy their associate degree general education requirements by completing the LACC G.E. pattern; Cal-GETC (fall 2025 and after); IGETC, CSU GE-Breadth (prior to fall 2025); IGETC for STEM, CSUGE for STEM (prior to fall 2025); associate degree from a U.S. regionally accredited institution (Students must meet the English, math and ethnic studies competency requirements); or bachelor's degree from a U.S. regionally accredited institution (Students must meet the ethnic studies competency requirement).

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
